# Sustainability, Democracy Development, and Work Stress-Related Health & Future Progress Monitoring Via JCQ2

General presentation

**Three major existentially dramatic challenges will be addressed:** (I) Sustainability in Socioeconomic Behavior, (II) Support for Democratic Development, and (III) Psychosocial Occupational Health,' (an accessible JCQ2 entry point). These theme's coverage, while vast, have several underlying common threads which can support a focused discussion of Positive Societal Futures. All of these issues are impossible to deflect attention from in current times.

**Our current societies are deeply challenged:** by climate change, by inequalities and by culture mix, and our objective is to reach a 'Good Society' characterized by high-lever actions, healthy work and democracy. How, then, from the current society to get a Good Society which is the focal topic of our Workshop (See, also the multi-stage, PPT-related discussion enclosed)? We think there are strong inter-relationships between sustainable economy and healthy work.

**The Workshop will review JCQ2 use for Progress Monitoring of:** "Sustainability, Democracy Development, and Work Stress-Related Health: What is at Stake for 'A Healthier Society?' - a subject we think could expand the practical and academic discourse. Thus, we are inviting international economists, sociologist, psychologist, epidemiologist, ergonomics, researchers in social law to work together on it and to review it.

## Workshop Design

Thanks to an interdisciplinary and international approach, the Workshop is designed to structure a dialogue about a new direction for society. The aim is to build platforms of positive actions to develop new growth, new ways of tackle sustainability, and illuminate pathways to see where we are going. Use of "new beliefs" in a workplace context, and the further elaboration of new criteria for progress at societal level means that we necessarily involve the (A) structure of our laws. And (B) the JCQ2 is a workplace-based questionnaire capable of monitoring how such progress is being made.
